ALL projects utilize the following

- Water cup to rinse paint brushes
- Paper towel to dry paint brushes
- Paint palette (this can be a paper plate)



In my art studio, I use art supplies purchased at Michaels

- Craft Smart acrylic paint is available in approximately 80 colors
- Artist's Loft 12-pack of flat & round synthetic brushes offers a variety of sizes
- Artist's Loft super value canvas packs are available in a range of sizes



Snail video

Snail/Sailboat paintings (geared for ages 4-7)

Canvases: 1 8x10, 1 9x12

Acrylic paints: white, black, green (light and dark), blue (light and dark), brown, orange, yellow, red, purple

Brushes: Larger brush for background, smaller brush for details, and a 1" foam brush for the design on the snail shell

Extra water cup: to mix light blue watercolor using acrylic paint above

Koala/Bear paintings (geared for ages 6-11)

Canvases: 2 9x12 canvases

Acrylic paints: white, black, blue, brown (light and dark), green (light and dark), gray, pink, yellow, red, pink, purple

Brushes: 1 medium sized paint brush for larger areas, and 1 small paintbrush for fine details

Drawing tools: Pencil, eraser, black crayon, black fine point Sharpie

Extra water cups: to mix green watercolor (koala), and light blue and brown watercolor (bear) using acrylic paint above

Dragon's Eye video

Dragon's Eye/Lighthouse paintings (geared for ages 10-15)

Canvases: 2 9x12

Acrylic paints: white, black, blue (light and dark), green, gray, red, yellow. Dragon's Eye recommendations: Either red and green, or blue and orange, or purple and yellow.

Brushes: 1 medium sized paint brush for larger areas, and 1 small paintbrush for fine details

Drawing tools: Pencil and eraser
